Abraham died at 175 (Gen 25:7). Was 86 when Ishmael was born (Gen. 16). Abraham was 99 years old when the covenant is made (Gen. 17:1). Was at least 110+ when told to offer Isaac; three days journey, climbed a mountain, tied a ram, etc., (Gen. 22). Remarried at the age of +140 and had children (Gen 25:1).

Sarah died at 127 (Gen 23:1). Was 10 years younger than Abraham. Was about 90 when Isaac was born (Gen. 21). Was 65 when taken into Pharaoh's harem (Gen. 12). Was 89 when taken into Abimelech's harem (Gen. 20).

Isaac died at 180 (Gen. 35:28). He was 40 when he married Rebekah (Gen 25:20) and was 60 when Esau and Jacob his first born were born (Gen. 25:26).

Jacob died at 147 (Gen 47:9; 49:33). Joseph died at 110 (Gen 50:26).

\* The Average life span to the generation of Eli/David where it stabilized at 70 years would have been 222 years.
